

**PARENTS' GUIDE TO THE
STUDENT APPLICATION PROCESS**

Listed below are the steps you will have to take to make a timely application for your child to attend a choice district in the next school year.

1. Submit a Notice of Intent to Participate in the Interdistrict Public School Choice Program to your district of residence. ***The notice must be received by your district of residence by April 25th.***
 - Expect to receive a notification from your district of residence letting you know whether your child may participate in the school choice program. ***The district of residence is required to provide this notification to you by May 9th.***
 - Submit an Application for Enrollment in the Choice District to the choice district. ***The application must be received by the choice district by May 16th.***

Attach a copy of the notification from your district of residence stating that your child may participate in the school choice program. The regulations provide that if you do not receive a notification from your district of residence, your child may participate in the school choice program.

If you did not receive a notification from your district of residence, make a note on the application that no notification was received.

- Expect a Notice of Acceptance or Rejection from the choice district ***by May 27th.***
- If your child has been accepted by the choice district, submit a Notice of Intent to Enroll to the choice district. ***The notice must be received by the choice district by June 10th.***
- If your child has been rejected by the choice district and placed on the waiting list, you may receive a Notice of Acceptance ***by June 17th.***
- If you receive a Notice of Acceptance by June 17th, submit a Notice of Intent to Enroll to the choice district. ***The notice must be received by the choice district by June 24th.***
