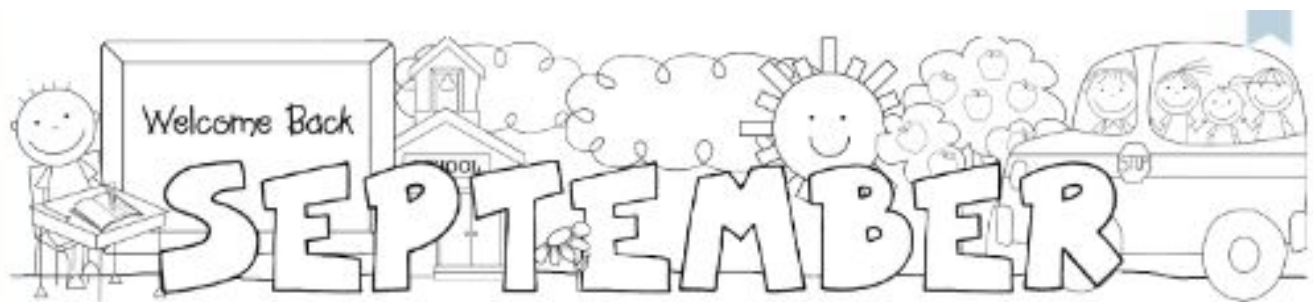



Choose two activities to complete.
