

New Jersey Department of Health and human Services is requiring that every student entering the sixth grade must have the following immunizations: Meningococcal and Tdap. Some students may have received these immunizations and just need to provide the proper documentation from their physician to the school. All documentation of immunizations must be prepared by the physician/office with their stamp. During annual visits to your physician, have vaccine and physical information documented, so student's school health records can be updated.

All students entering the sixth grade must have the Meningococcal and Tdap immunizations and proper documentation to enter school in September. Please provide the documentation to the nurse's office prior to August 15, 2015. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me.
